Dear Parent/ carer,

I would like to first or all wish you a happy and healthy new year! As a result of the First Minister's announcement on the 4th January the school will be delivering learning on-line to our pupils to stem the spread of the new strain of COVID 19.

How will this work?

From Monday 11th January until Monday 1st February (subject to review) pupils will follow their normal school timetable via their iPad and not in school. Teachers will be on-line providing activities, teaching and supporting pupils during the periods they would normally teach them. This will take place in the class Showbie groups. Since pupils are not attending the school there is no need for the staggered start and end to the days and therefore the school day will look as follows for all pupils:

Timetable

P1 -3 – 8.50 start (including senior phase pupils)

Break 11.05-11.20

Assembly 11.20 - 11.35 – these will happen once or twice per week. Pupils will be notified via email, on Monday morning, by their year head of their assembly days and how to join – parents are welcome to sit with their child to hear the assembly messages if available.

P4 -5 – (including S1-3 pupils having P5 starting at 12.20)

Lunch 1.05 – 1.50

P6-7 – Monday, Tuesday and Thursday are the only days with P7 – there is no extra period for senior pupils at the end of the day as P1 at normal time.

We are very keen to keep our young people in the routine of being "up" for school and not turning night into day as we know this can impact negatively on mental health. Therefore teachers will be available to support pupils during the school day 8.50- 15.20 (14.35) but not in evenings, work submitted then will reviewed/ given feedback during the school day – normally during the class time.

Pastoral Care will be connecting with their house groups weekly as usual with one period more intensely focussing on individual support, they will let pupils know which periods these are. PSHE will have a strong focus on positive mental health.

This is again a new way of operating for us as a school and we hope that everything goes according to plan, however you can contact us as below should you have any questions.

Almost all school staff will be working from home. If you need to speak to someone about a specific issue with your child you should contact their Pastoral Care teacher in the first instance.
