

## Parent Guide to Tracking

Each S3/4/5/6 tracking report will show 2 grades.

**Current Target** – The grade that a pupil has **the potential** to achieve at the end of S4 if they work consistently.

**On Track to Achieve** – The grade that each pupil is **currently working at**.

*Where the current grade is higher than the on track to achieve grade this will be an area that pupils along with their personal support tutor will set targets for.*

**Please note the different grades used for the current S3 pupils as they will be sitting the new qualifications in S4.**

5/6 = Access 3

3 = A

4 = B/C

5/6 = concerns about achieving Int 1 but should achieve Access 3

7 = concerns about achieving Access 3

9 = serious concerns about achieving Access 3

**Standard Grade**

1 = credit

2 = credit

3 = general

4 = general

5 = foundation

6 = foundation

7 = concerns about achieving foundation

9 = serious concerns about achieving found

**Intermediate 2**

1 = A

2 = B/C

3/4 = concerns about achieving Int 2 but should achieve Int 1

7 = concerns about achieving Int 2/Int 1

9 = serious concerns about achieving Int 2/Int 1

**Higher**

1/2 = A

3/4 = B

5/6 = C

7 = D

8 = concerns about achieving Higher

9 = serious concerns about achieving Higher
