- Contributing to a trip for S1 every year during their first week of secondary
- Supporting the upcoming transformation of the back playground into a multi-purpose sports area
- Co-ordinating the end of year awards ceremony
- Rewarding two pupils (one from lower and one from upper school) for their voluntary 'Work in the Community' with the Parent Council's Award Shield
